

TAVISTOCK FARMERS' MARKET

MARKET GUIDELINES AND RULES

1. Market Times: Summer 9am – 2pm, Winter 9am – 1pm.
2. The current fee is £30 per single stall, £55 per double stall. Electricity an additional £3 where supplied. Tavistock Farmers' Market Association reserves the right to alter this by giving notice of 1 calendar month. The fee will be collected on the day of the market by the Market Manager.
3. Where a stallholder is unable to attend a market, £0 is charged for the 1st 2 markets missed in a calendar year. Thereafter the full stall fee will be charged per missed market, to be paid at the next market attended.
4. There is no vehicular access onto Bedford Square. Loading and unloading must take place from the loading bay at Bedford Square. Vehicles should be clear of the loading bay by 8.45 am.
5. There is no allocated parking for producers; parking is available in local pay and display car parks (up to 30 cwt). Please ask the Market Manager for directions.
6. The Market Manager is solely responsible for allocating places and stall positions at the Market, and runs the Market on the day. There are no reserved pitches.
7. Electrical equipment must have Portable Appliance Testing carried out regularly by a qualified person. All items must be entered into the Electrical Equipment Log held by the Market Manager.
8. Gas appliances must hold a gas safety certificate issued by a qualified person. All items must be entered into the Gas Appliances Log held by the Market Manager.
9. Produce must be displayed within the stall itself and must not be placed on the area in front or to the side of the stall unless by prior arrangement. The structure of the stall and lacing must not be changed by stallholders (you may move the tables).
10. Samples are encouraged but should be placed at the producer's own stall. Shouting to entice customers is not allowed.
11. Trading Standards and Environmental Health will inspect the Market on a regular basis. It is the stallholders' responsibility to comply with current food hygiene regulations at all times, and Tavistock Farmers' Market Association may pass on information about producers when required.
12. Only produce certified by the Soil Association or other national certification bodies can be labelled as 'Organic'.
13. A copy of the Association General Regulations and Constitution will be given to you prior to your application. You will be asked to sign that you have read, understood and agree to abide by the General Regulations and Constitution.
